

KURSUNLU – ASPENDOS

FROM ANTALYA / BELEK / SIDE/ KEMER AREAS

In the morning, departure from your hotel with the first stop being Kurşunlu Waterfalls which is located 19 km from Antalya at the end of a 7 km road branching off to the north of the Antalya-Serik-Alanya highway at a point 12 km from Antalya. It is reduced to a mere trickle in the summer months. The waterfalls is on one of the tributaries of the Aksu River and its situation in the midst of a pine forest is of quite exceptionally beauty. The countryside around the water forms a lovely picnic and pleasure spot only twenty minutes from the centre of the city of Antalya.

Continuing further East will bring you to the site of one of the best preserved amphitheatres of all times: Aspendos, which is still used today for many live performances of Ballet, Opera and classical works of art due to its fabulous acoustics and large seating capacity (15,000). Close to the theatre, the remains of the largest aqueduct in ancient Anatolia can also be seen.

Here you will also have the opportunity of shopping for carpets, silver and copper ware or trinkets and souvenirs.
