

PERGE – ASPENDOS – SIDE

In the morning, departure from your hotel with the first stop being Perge that is 18 kms East of Antalya. In this area the Hittites settled in 1500 BC and St. Paul reportedly stopped on of his journeys. Here, you will be able to see some fine examples of the old colonnaded streets, agora, bath, stadium and theatre.

Continuing further East will bring you to the site of one of the best-preserved amphitheatres of all times: Aspendos, which is still used today for many live performances of Ballet, Opera and classical works of art due to its fabulous acoustics and large seating capacity (15,000). Close to the theatre, the remains of the largest aqueduct in ancient Anatolia can also be seen.

The tour will break for lunch before you reach Side, where you will see the theatre standing proudly at its entrance, and next thereto, the remains of an agora and the extensive baths, which now house one of the finest archaeological collections.

Here, you will also have the opportunity of shopping for carpets, silver and copper ware or trinkets and souvenirs.
